Narrative

Gulfport, FL-- Update: Reference Laced Gummy Worms at Boca Ciega High School

Two students at Boca Ciega High School have been arrested and charged with F.S.S. 893.13(1)(c), which is a 2nd degree felony for delivering a controlled substance within 1000 feet of a school. A 3rd arrest is pending for the same offense. Only 3 students will be charged criminally as they were the only ones involved with "delivery" of a controlled substance. The other students will have school consequences.

For your convenience I have attached the charging statute below:

(c) Except as authorized by this chapter, a person may not sell, manufacture, or deliver, or possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver, a controlled substance in, on, or within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising a child care facility as defined in s. [402.302](#) or a public or private elementary, middle, or secondary school between the hours of 6 a.m. and 12 midnight, or at any time in, on, or within 1,000 feet of real property comprising a state, county, or municipal park, a community center, or a publicly owned recreational facility. As used in this paragraph, the term "community center" means a facility operated by a nonprofit community-based organization for the provision of recreational, social, or educational services to the public.
